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Quilt Entry Guidelines

- 1. Quilter(s) may submit their completed work by submitting an entry form, two (2) digital photos, and the story behind the quilt.
- 2. Quilter(s) must live within one of the six Rocky Mountain states (Colorado, Idaho, Montana, New Mexico, Utah, or Wyoming, or the Native First Nations of the region).
- 3. Each quilt may be entered in a maximum of two (2) categories.
- 4. Quilt(s) must be no larger than 90" in width and 80" in length.
- 5. All quilts must remain on display until 4 p.m. Sunday, September 19, 2021.
- 6. Two (2) photos must be submitted with the entry:
 - A full-view photo of the completed quilt showing all four corners of the quilt. No part of the quilt may be obscured.
 - A photo of the entrant(s) from the shoulders up. If a group is submitting, please use a photo that includes all of the participants. Multiple photos of each individual is also accepted.
- 7. A brief narrative of the quilt must be given with each entry including but not limited to: materials used and where they are from geographically, start and completion date, the technique used, type of quilt, and inspiration for the design.
- 8. Quilts must be clean, free of odor, and in excellent condition. Quilts that are soiled, torn, or incomplete will be disqualified for both entry and display.
- 9. Entries may be mailed or hand-delivered to the Higher Ground Fair Home Office.
 - Please note: the mailing address for entry forms and for quilts is not the same!
- 10. Quilts will be accepted for sale. If you are interested in selling your quilt, indicate it and the price on the registration form.
