Therapy Dog Guidelines

1. Health Rules and Regulations: All dogs must be accompanied by a current Rabies Vaccination Certificate, stating that the animal has been vaccinated by a veterinarian in accordance with current recommendations of the Compendium of Animal Rabies Control as prepared by the National Association of State Public Health Veterinarians (NASPHV).

2. Identification: All dogs must be in identifying therapy/service dog vests while on the Wyoming Territorial Prison State Historic Park property. Handlers must also be in identifying lanyards provided by Higher Ground Fair staff.

3. Therapy dog welcome packet: Each handler will receive a Welcome Packet upon arrival at the Fair. The packet will contain one free ticket to the fair, a \$10 food voucher (which you will receive halfway through your four hours), a free T-shirt ticket (you will receive the T-shirt at the end of your four hours), and an identifying lanyard for the handler to wear during the Fair.

4. Off-limit Areas: The therapy dogs and their handlers are welcome to explore and enjoy the Fair while they are resting or after their scheduled time(s) are completed. However, please keep in mind that there are areas of the Fair that have animals that cannot be around dogs under any circumstance. Upon your arrival to the fair, a Higher Ground Fair staff member will point out the areas where dogs are not allowed. We ask that you respect the animals and the Higher Ground Fair staff by keeping your dog(s) out of these areas to make sure all our guests are safe, happy, and healthy during the fair.

5. Time Frame: We ask that each Handler and their dog spend a minimum of four hours of the day at the Fair over the course of the weekend and sign up for at least two time slots. Each time-slot (listed below) is approximately one hour. If you are unable to be at the Fair for a consecutive four hours, please let Higher Ground Fair Staff know in advance. Times may be adjusted on a case-by-case basis; however, a full Welcome Packet may not be given to those who serve less than four hours.
